WARRANT OF ARREST


TO ANY OFFICER OF THE LAW:
GREETINGS:

You are hereby commanded to arrest, **JOSEPH SAREÑO PURALAN** who is said to be found at North Baybay, Galas, Dipolog City and deliver him to the nearest police station or jail.

Bail Recommended P36,000 each.

This warrant must be executed within TEN (10) DAYS from receipt hereof. Within TEN (10) DAYS after the expiration of each period, the officer to whom this warrant was assigned for execution must make a report to the judge who issued the warrant and, in case of his/her failure to execute the same, shall state the reasons therefore. This warrant of arrest remain VALID and should be served even after ten (10) days and need NOT be RETURNED to the Judge until the respondent is arrested or unless recalled by the Judge (Rule 113, Sec. 4, 1935 Rules of Criminal Procedure).
